Public transportation

- The Helsinki-Vantaa airport is 13 km from the Exhibition & Convention Centre. This journey is easiest by taxi, which will take approximately 15 minutes.
- There is a taxi rank in front of the southern entrance of the Exhibition & Convention Centre.
- All local and long-distance trains stop at the Pasila railway station, just a 300-metre walk from the Exhibition & Convention Centre. Trains from the city centre to Pasila take just five minutes.
- Trams 7A, 7B, and 9 to the city centre stop in front of the southern entrance of the Exhibition & Convention Centre.
