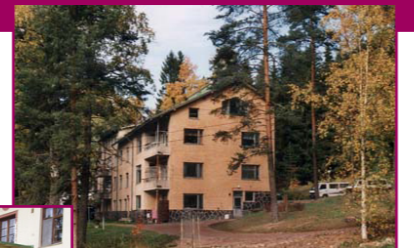

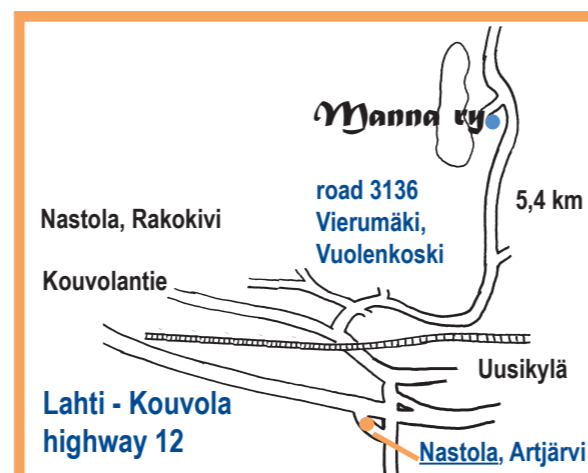

# Manna Association

## What is Manna Association?

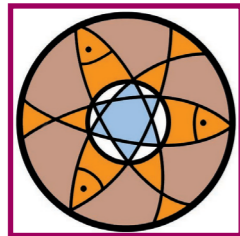
**Manna Association is a non-profit, professionally staffed organization, no capital share, in Nastola that provides services to supplement communal services, and creates jobs. Manna is funded mainly by the service fees paid by the customers or municipalities.**

Manna Association was founded in 1996 in the town of Nastola, Finland. The values of Manna are based on Christian principles of mercy ministry (*diaconia*). Manna's goals are to

- support and assist families and individuals of all ages in coping with the challenges of everyday life
- participate in international aid (rules §2)

Manna Association is not associated with any specific denomination, but operates as a channel for interdenominational mercy ministry.

There are over 60 (individual) members in the association. The Annual fee for membership is 15 € for a member and 10 € for a supporter. The Annual meeting is held in spring, in April or May, and covers annual report, financial statement, action plan and budget, nominations of the chairman, board members, and auditors.

## Manna's services

### Manna Association provides care for elderly people

**Manna has established two care home units of 24 hour care, and provides home delivered services for the elderly, and daycare for children.**

The State Provincial Office, which guides and supervises the private social services, has granted a licence of 43 placements for service housing and supported accommodation to Manna Association as a provider of private social and health care services.

Housing services are provided for people who need help, assistance, or other care which cannot be provided in the person's own home by making use of other social services.

**Manna homes provide 24 hour care.** It is possible to access Manna Home with a **service voucher** granted by the municipality.

Mannakoti 1 (**Manna Home 1**) is a care home unit of 24 places for the elderly people, who do not need institutional treatment in hospital and are no longer able to manage in their own homes.

Mannakoti 2+3 (**Manna Home 2+3**) is a care home unit of 19 places for people, who have been diagnosed with dementia.

The staff of Manna homes consists of a doctor, director of nursing, registered nurses, practical nurses, a physiotherapist, a trained masseur, and nursing assistants. In addition there is kitchen staff, laundry staff, janitors, a house manager and administrative staff.

Manna homes are located in the village of Uusikylä at Nastola Municipality, some 25 kilometers east from the city of Lahti in Southern Finland. The buildings are adjoined by a lake in the scenic countryside.

In addition to the housing services, Manna Association provides **home services** for the elderly, such as home care nursing, meals on wheels, bathing, cleaning, cooking at home, and running errands.

Manna Association also runs a **children's day care center** for 21 children in North-East of Nastola, manages a **cafeteria** of "Kiveriön Kievari" in Lahti, and provides **training and courses** on first aid, food service hygiene test (food hygiene certificate), and project administration.

## You are welcome to join Manna!

Manna's regularly scheduled Theme Days have been popular among the members. They consist of a meal built around the theme (such as harvest time, freindship, mother's day, fatherhood, seasons etc.), a variety of programs, and singing together.

As a member you are eligible to a 10 % discount of the catering services of Kiveriön Kievari or Manna's kitchen (except service charges).
